*The app itself is free, but you will need to pay for an internet connection.

Burnable waste

Collected twice a week



- Place the waste in a designated bag.
- The waste must be smaller than 50 square centimeters.
- Drain off the water from the waste.
- Recyclable papers belong to "Used papers."

Non-burnable waste

Collected once a month



- Place the waste directly in the container with no bag.
- Make sure to remove batteries.
- Completely empty aerosol cans and make a hole.

Plastic containers and packaging

Collected once a week



- Place the items in a designated bag.

Three steps to disposal

①See if it has a "Pla Mark."

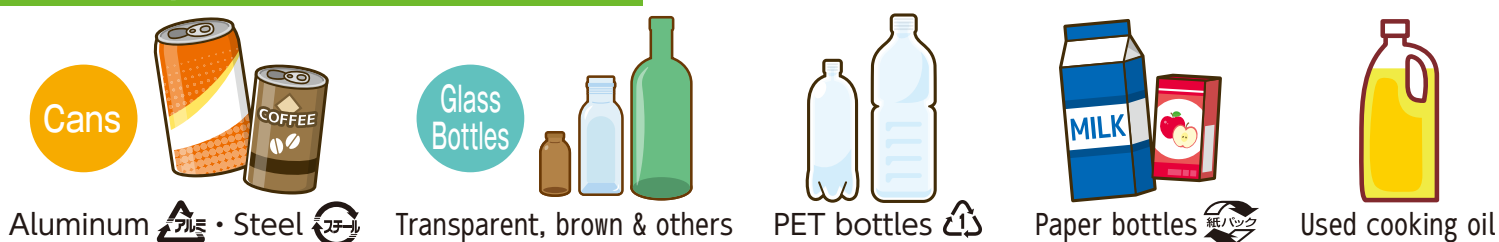
②Rinse dirty items.

③Place the items in a designated bag.



Recyclable waste

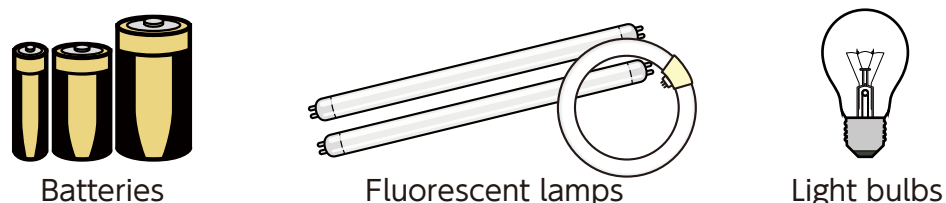
Collected twice a month



- Rinse all items before recycling.
- Do not crush cans and PET bottles.
- Do not place paper bottles when it rains.
- Used cooking oil can be accepted only if it is vegetable oil.

Batteries, fluorescent lamps & light bulbs

Collected three times a year (April, August & December) otherwise please bring your waste to a local bulky waste collection center or a recycling center.



- Take out the items from bags or boxes.
- Please contact the shop you bought batteries, shops, or manufacturers to take back used batteries such as button batteries, rechargeable batteries (NiCad batteries, Nickel-based batteries, and Lithium-ion batteries.)

Used papers & textile waste

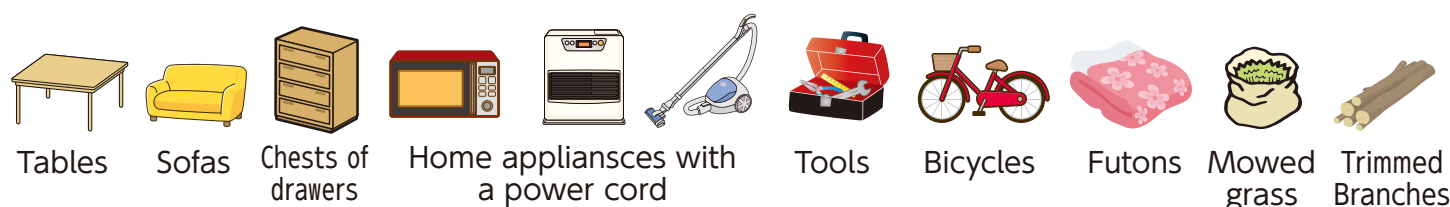
Please bring your waste to a local bulky waste collection center or a recycling center.



- Remove vinyl products, metals, or any non-paper items from the waste.
- Dispose of the items with stain or a smell as burnable.
- You can also use private recycling centers.

Bulky waste

Please bring your waste to a local bulky waste collection center or a recycling center.



- Make sure to remove any batteries and fuel.
- Only mowed grass and trimmed branches on your residential property (not from fields or mountains) are accepted. And trimmed branches must be shorter than 1.5 meters and thinner than 25 centimeters.
- Tie futons tightly.

The items cannot be accepted

Contact the shop you bought it or a shop to take back the items.
